When you login on any device BrowZine automatically syncs to that device so your latest changes and settings are automatically available, along with access to the latest issues of your favourite journals.

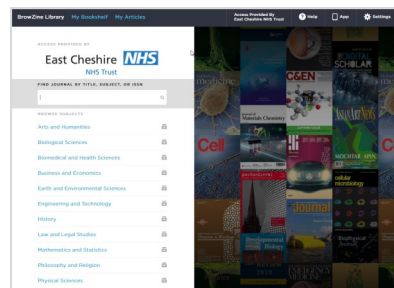


All our journals are available electronically. To view the journal titles, and browse the issues, open **BrowZine**: www.browzine.com/libraries/1293 or navigate via the Library Services menu of the library website.

Search for a journal title, or subject.
Note: this search screen does not allow you to search for a specific article.

From the list of results, click on the journal you want to view.

To open the full-text of an article you will need an NHS Athens account. Visit www.eastcheshirehslibrary/athens.html for more information on Athens.

By default it displays the current issue

Click on an article title if you want to view the full-text. You will then be prompted for your **NHS Athens** username and password.

Click 'Change year' to browse to a particular issue

Click on an issue to open it

Click the 'expand' arrow if you would like to save the citation to a reference manager software package, or to share the article via social media or email.

Any issues which we don't have access to the full-text will have a padlock symbol next to them. If there is no padlock we have access to the full-text.

One of the benefits of BrowZine is the ability to save a 'bookshelf' of journals and articles for quick, easy access to your favourite journals. You will need to create a free personal account - click on 'Settings' (top-right corner) and click 'Login'. You can then sign up for an account, or login once you have created one. To add journals to your bookshelf, first browse to the

theBMJ (British Medical Journal)

your bookshelf from the link at the top of the page. You can organise the journals onto different shelves on different bookcases, and can rename them too! When you login on different devices this configuration will automatically sync and will display a bubble indicating how many new articles you have available to read.

You can also save lists of favourite articles for future reference. These can be organised into different collections, so you can keep articles for a research project, personal development, etc grouped together.
