We recently welcomed Helen Fishwick to the library team. Helen is our new Library Assistant and works every Thursday on the library reception desk.

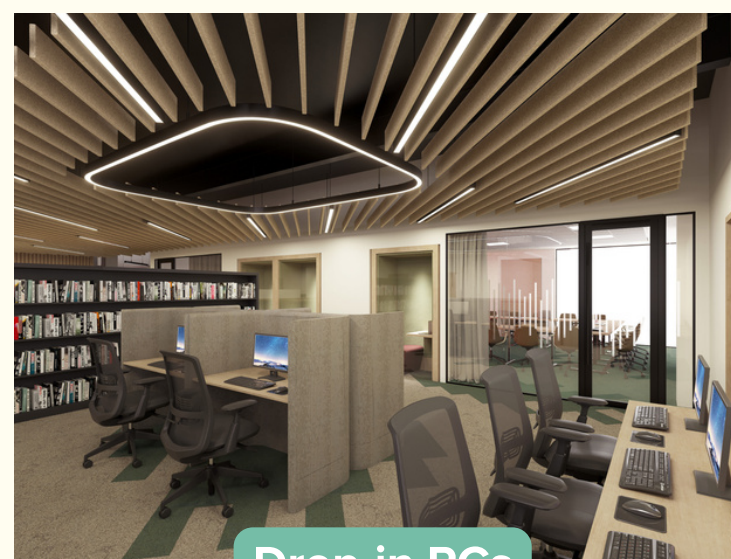
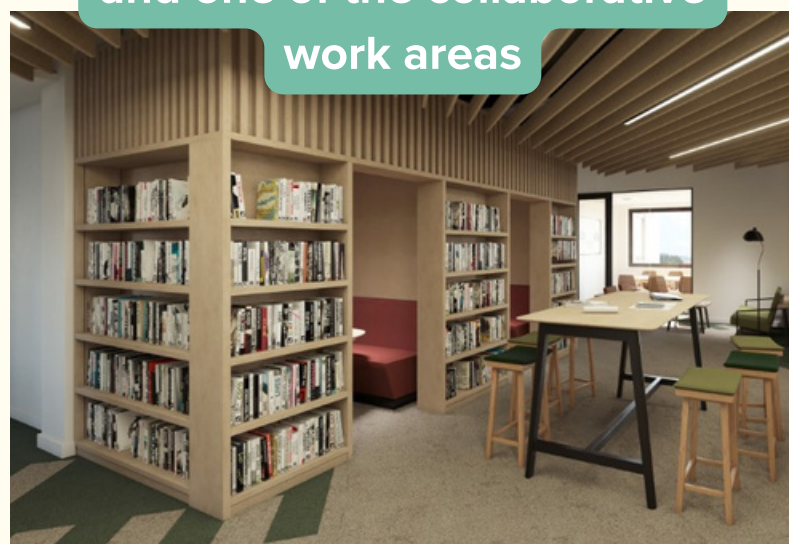

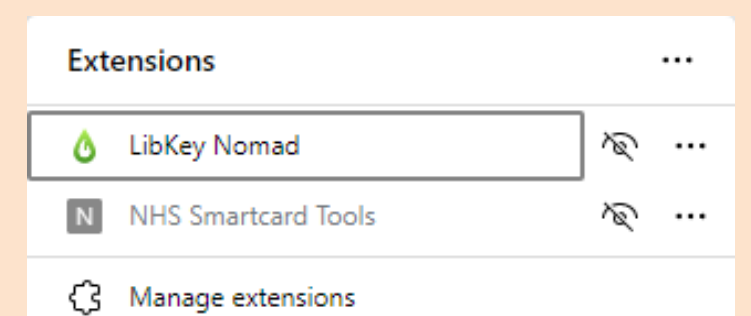

LibKey Nomad

Accessing journal articles just got easier!

Health Education England has purchased a national subscription to LibKey to make it easier to find and access full-text journal articles.

Download the free LibKey Nomad browser extension, or on trust PCs activate it from the jigsaw 'extensions' button on the browser toolbar. Select 'East Cheshire NHS Trust' from the list of organisations.



As you search databases and certain websites (like PubMed, Google Scholar, Wikipedia, UpToDate) LibKey will provide a link to the full-text (if available) or provide a link to directly request the article from the library. Contact us for a quick demo!
