

The Library & Knowledge Service is here to support evidence-based decision making at East Cheshire NHS Trust. We provide access to a wide range of quality information resources, and tailored support for staff, whatever role you are in.



Library services are available to all staff and volunteers at East Cheshire NHS Trust, and students who are here on placement. We are happy to provide Library inductions for any new members of staff, or staff who haven't used the Library before. We provide access to:

- Databases, books and journals, UpToDate, BMJ Best Practice & other online resources
- IT facilities (PCs, printing, photocopying & scanning, laptop loans)
- Inter-library requests (ILLs) for anything not kept in stock
- Enquiry service
- Study space, including quiet study pods
- Fiction and wellbeing collections; book club
- Educational games
- e-Learning support
- Digital and search skills training

Online Resources
